





Re: Potential Hunting of Wolves as a Trophy Animal

As you may be aware, as the result of a decision by the Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit, wolves in Wyoming have once again been removed from the Fish and Wildlife Service's list of threatened and endangered species. As a result, management of the wolf once again resides with the State of Wyoming. I want to remind you that, until such time that the Governor approves regulations promulgated by the Wyoming Game and Fish Department for the hunting of wolves as a trophy game animal, wolves may not be hunted as a trophy game animal in Wyoming.
